



**Thank you, Bainbridge Island!** It takes a caring, connected community to save an ecological treasure like **Rockaway Bluff Preserve**, and together we've done just that.

This expansive, 35-acre property, perched above Rockaway Beach and visible from the ferry, is home to an abundance of wild creatures—from foxes to flying squirrels to highly vulnerable bird species—and offers a critical link between the Eagle Harbor and Blakely Harbor ecosystems.

With the help of more than 1,000 conservation-minded supporters the Land Trust raised the funds needed to purchase the property and ensure its protection and stewardship for generations to come.
